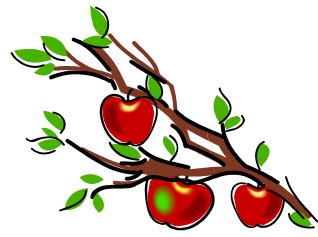

What is a Workcamp?

Workcamps are intensive one-week mission trips of service. These Workcamps offer individuals and youth an opportunity to perform hands-on home-repair projects for needy residents, many of whom have seen their homes damaged by natural disaster or just years of can't afford to fix disrepair.

Approximately 400+ individuals and youth from around the country will spend one week in our community performing needed repairs. Most importantly, they will grow in Christian faith through service.

What is done that week?

These youth, with adult supervision, can perform a variety of work on each home, depending upon the needs of the residents. Some of the types of work that can be completed include light carpentry, interior and exterior painting, deck or porch staining pressure washing, caulking, and landscaping.

Also, they can construct steps, porches, wheelchair ramps, and simple drywall. They can also install siding, skirting, insulation and some windows and doors, depending upon the difficulty of the project.

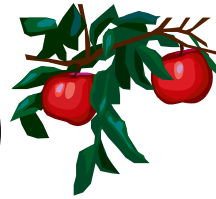
